ORDER FROM JULY 15, 2010
HEARING

THIS MATTER being opened to the Court by Jamie Epstein, attorney appearing for Plaintiffs, with Eric Harrison, Esquire appearing for Defendant, Audubon School District, by way of return of an Order to Show Cause for a permanent injunction and other relief, with the Court having entered a preliminary injunction on May 13, 2010, and the Court having considered the papers submitted by the parties and having heard oral argument and setting forth the Court's reasons upon the record on July 15, 2010 and for good cause appearing;

IT IS on this 1st day of September 2010, ORDERED as follows:

1. Plaintiff's request for a permanent injunction restraining Defendant from placing Plaintiff, T.D., in a "weighted vest," without Plaintiff's consent, and except if T.D. poses a danger to himself or others, is GRANTED;
2. The Court DENIES Plaintiff's claim for a per se violation of LAD;
3. Plaintiff's request to have Defendant pay Plaintiffs' reasonable attorney fees and costs pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-27.1 is RESERVED; and
4. This case shall now proceed on the Complaint.
